Northwest Outfall Sewer Siphon Rehabilitation

Beginning in mid-March 2023

Fenced Construction Areas are Off-Limits – DO NOT ENTER

- The inlet and outlet siphon structures, located near the 18th Hole are being replaced
- The new siphon structure will reduce the amount of turbulence within the system, thereby reducing/eliminating the sewer odors currently experienced near this area

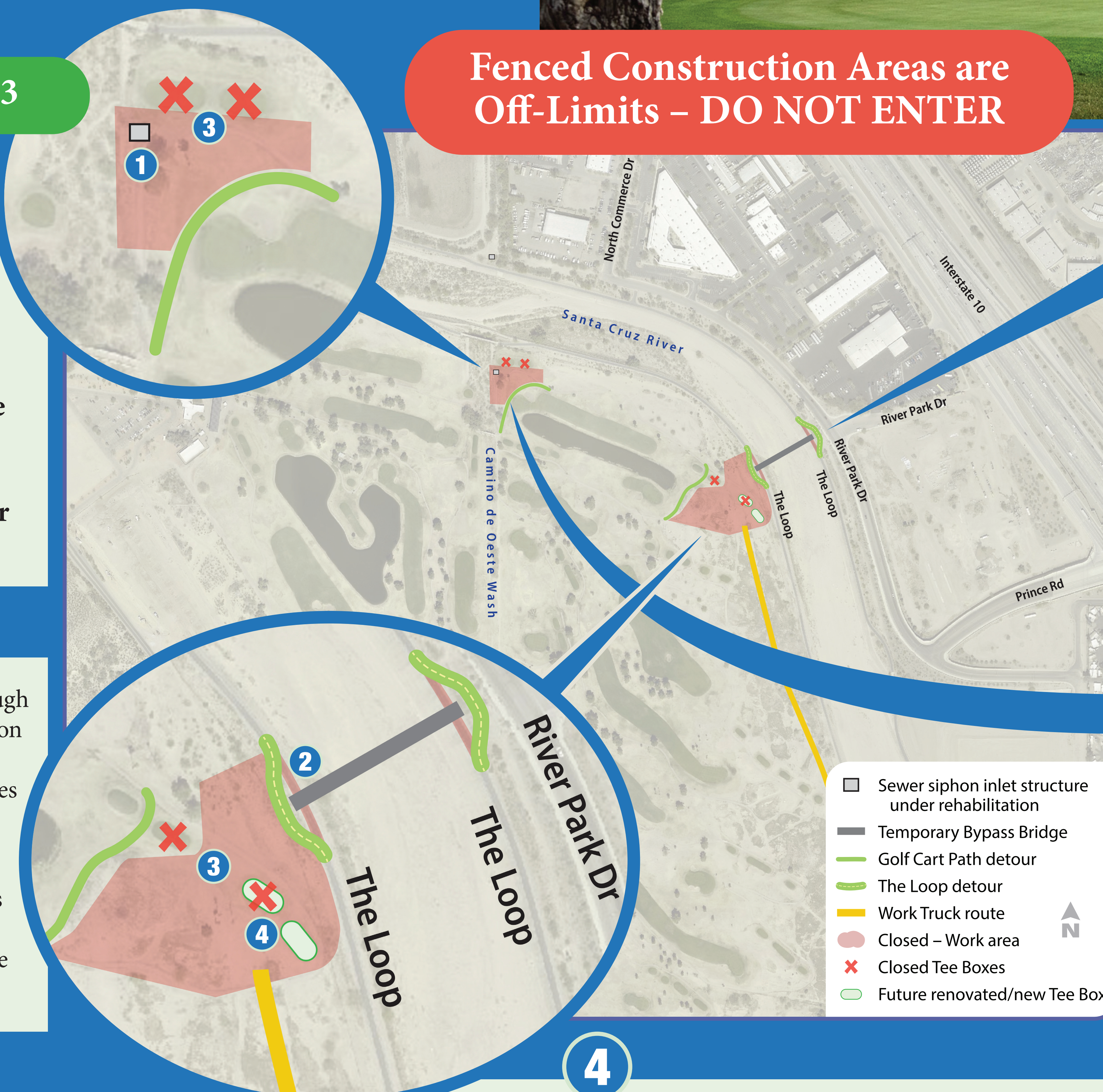
- The wastewater currently flowing through the pipes and structures being worked on will need to be bypassed – temporarily pumped around the pipes and structures being rehabilitated
- Hunter Contracting will install the temporary, above ground, sewer bypass across portions of the Silverbell Golf Course. The bypass will remain in place through the completion of the project

- To safely complete this project, it will require closing a few Tee Boxes and detouring the cart path at Holes 17 and 18

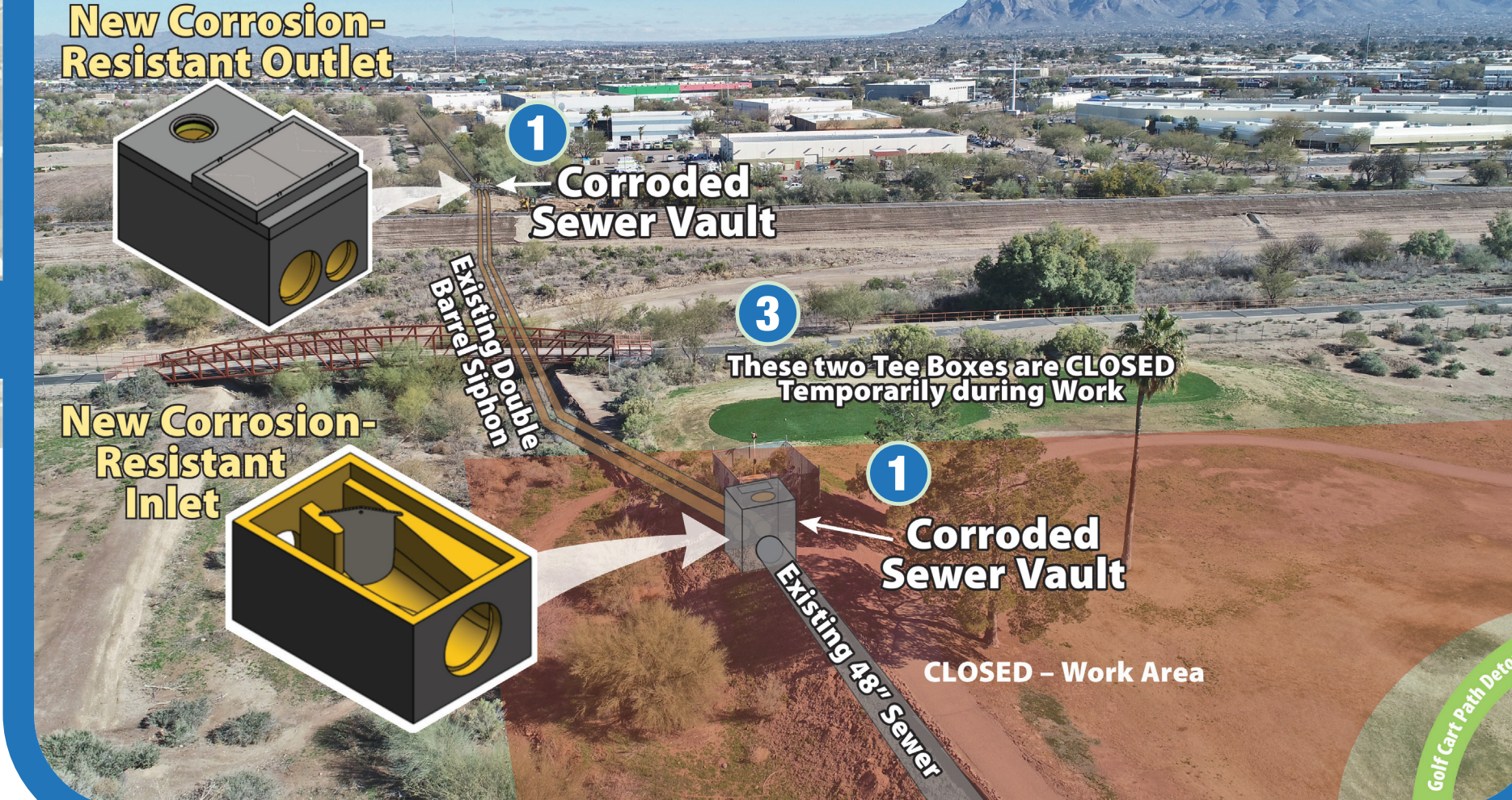
- When rehabilitation of the outfall siphon structure is complete, Hunter Contracting will work with personnel at Silverbell Golf Course to restore one of the 17th Hole Tee Boxes to its pre-construction condition along with replacing another Tee Box that has settled or sunken over time

- Some existing sewer lines will also be repaired or replaced
- The contractor will have an employee on site 24-hours per day, seven days per week to monitor the bypass system the entire time it is in operation
- Work is expected to be completed by the end of August 2023
