


22ND STREET / ALVERNON WAY INTERSECTION

Partial Closure for sewer and water infrastructure improvements

6 PM, Friday, MARCH 4, THROUGH 6 AM, Monday, MARCH 7, 2016



The intersection of 22nd Street and Alvernon Way will be partially closed at 6 p.m. Friday, March 4, through 6 a.m. Monday, March 7, 2016. **The following restrictions will be in place on 22nd Street and Alvernon Way during this phase of work:**

- Eastbound 22nd Street between Country Club and Alvernon Way will be reduced to one travel lane.
 One eastbound through lane and right turns will be permitted at the intersection of 22nd Street and Alvernon Way.
- Northbound Alvernon Way between 29th and 22nd Streets will be reduced to one travel lane, channeling motorists into the right-turn only lane at 22nd Street.
- Westbound 22nd Street between Swan Road and Columbus Boulevard will be reduced to two travel lanes. All turn movements will be permitted.
- Westbound 22nd Street between Columbus Boulevard and Alvernon Way will be reduced to one travel lane, channeling motorists into the right-turn only lane at Alvernon Way.
- Southbound Alvernon Way, between Broadway and 22nd Street will be reduced to one travel lane, channeling motorists into the right-turn only lane at 22nd Street.
- Bicyclists traveling through the area may use the full travel lane, but for safety considerations, should seek alternate routes if possible.
- Pedestrian access will be maintained, but for safety considerations, pedestrians should seek alternate routes if possible.
- Business and residential access will be maintained.
- Officers will be on site to help direct motorists and pedestrians through the area.

BUSINESSES ACCESSIBLE AT ALL TIMES

During the weekend partial closure, all businesses along 22nd Street can be accessed from the east end of 22nd Street at Swan and Columbus and from the west end at Country Club and Randolph Way.

22ND STREET / ALVERNON WAY INTERSECTION Partial Closure for sewer and water infrastructure improvements

Pima County Regional **Wastewater Reclamation** Department (RWRD) and its contractor, KE&G Construction, Inc., will begin work on the 22nd Street **Sewer Augmentation project** in March 2016. This \$2.0 million project will place a new one-mile section of sewer along 22nd Street and repair the existing sewer to increase overall capacity as the existing pipe is at, or near, its maximum flow capacity. Manholes along this stretch of roadway will also be evaluated and repaired or replaced. The sewer improvements are expected to be completed in six months. Weather or mechanical failure could impact this schedule.

BUSINESSES OPEN AND ACCESSIBLE AT ALL TIMES

During the construction on 22nd Street, you can still access the businesses in the area. Please continue to visit your favorite stores and utilize the services during construction.

Additionally, Pima County RWRD and Tucson Water are working collaboratively to replace a 63-year-old water main along with installing a new access vault structure that is located in the intersection of 22nd Street and Alvernon Way.

- On Wednesday, March 2 the contractor will begin to prepare for the weekend closure at the 22nd Street and Alvernon Way intersection. Work will include the isolation of smaller water lines in the area and draining water lines that will be replaced. Construction activities will take place at various times throughout the day and night. Motorists should expect left turn restrictions from northbound Alvernon Way to westbound 22nd Street the night of March 2, and restrictions in the left through lane southbound Alvernon Way from March 2 through March 4.
- On **March 4**, the contractor will begin the first phase of this reconstruction project with the closure of the 22nd Street and Alvernon Way intersection to replace the water main. (See details on reverse) On Monday, March 7, the intersection will

- reopen to through traffic, however, some lane restrictions and reductions of left-turn lanes will remain in place throughout March 2016.
- In early April 2016, when work at the intersection is complete, the contractor will begin installing new sewer line along the north side of 22nd Street between Alvernon Way and Swan Road. As work progresses eastward, motorists should expect lane restrictions and temporary closures of side streets and intersections. Most of the work will be completed at night. For safety purposes, **some traffic** control will be in place 24 **hours** per day. Bicyclists traveling through the area may use the full travel lane, but for safety considerations, should seek alternate routes if possible.

When complete, this project will increase the sewer capacity and improve the lifespan of the sewer and water infrastructure in the area.
