

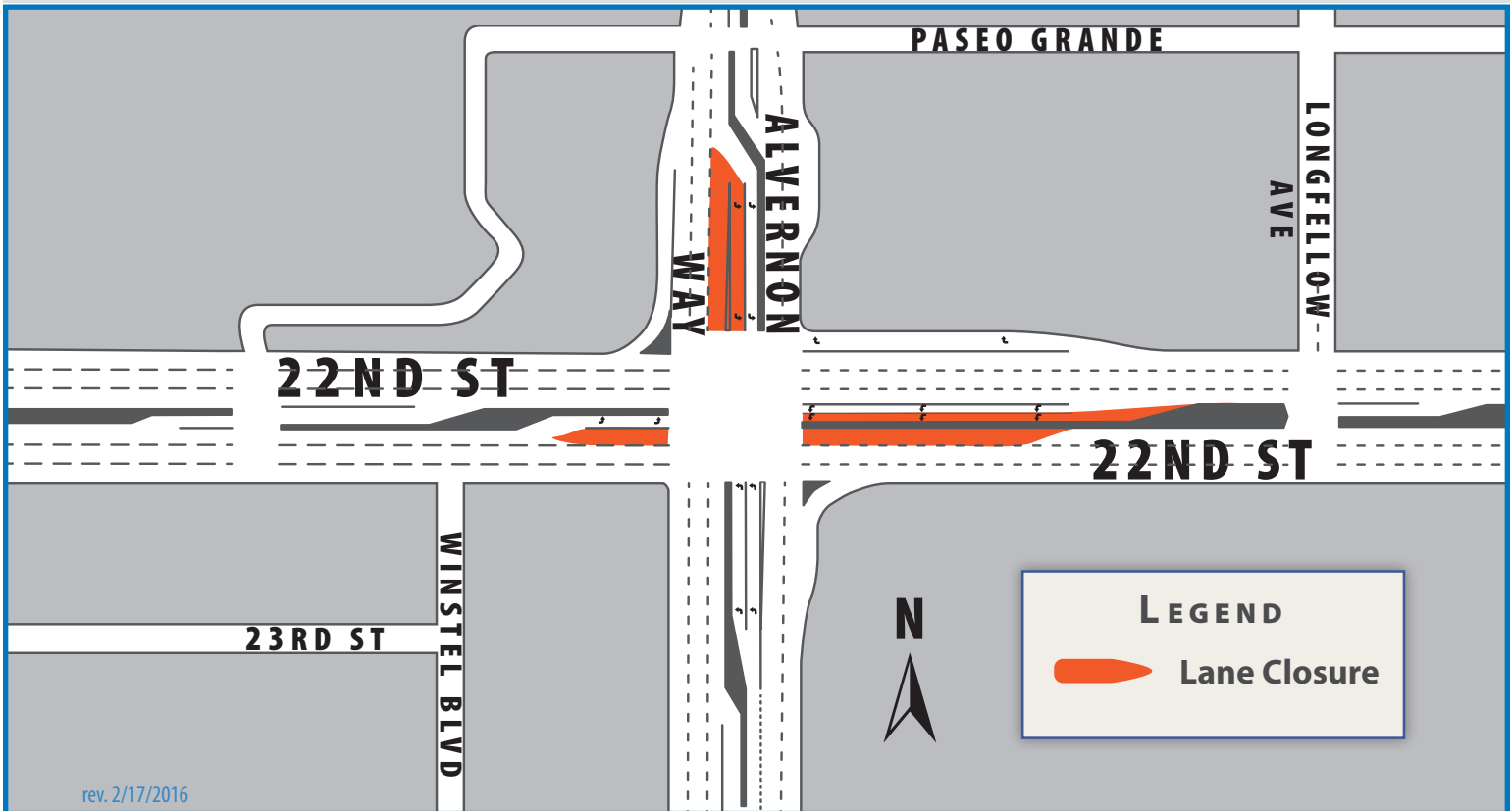


22ND STREET / ALVERNON WAY INTERSECTION

SEWER AND WATER INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS

Project info: Pima County Regional Wastewater Reclamation Department (RWRD) and its contractor, KE&G Construction, Inc., will begin work on the 22nd Street Sewer Augmentation project in March 2016. This \$2.0 million project will place a new one-mile section of sewer along 22nd Street and repair the existing sewer to increase overall capacity as the existing pipe is at, or near, its maximum flow capacity. Manholes along this stretch of roadway will also be evaluated and repaired or replaced. The sewer improvements are expected to be completed in six months. Weather or mechanical failure could impact this schedule.

The following traffic control will be in place beginning at 6 a.m. on Monday, March 7, 2016 and will remain in place through March, 2016 while the contractor completes water and sewer infrastructure improvements:

Southbound Alvernon

- Through travel reduced to two lanes
- Left turn movements reduced to one left-turn lane
- Right turn movements are unrestricted

Northbound Alvernon

- All through travel lanes open
- Left-turn movements unrestricted
- Right turn movements unrestricted

Eastbound 22nd Street

- Through travel reduced to two lanes
- Left turn movements unrestricted
- Right turn movements unrestricted

Westbound 22nd Street

- All through travel lanes open
- Left turn movements reduced to one left-turn lane
- Right turn movements unrestricted
